

## Installing BrioQuery v. 6

### Mac Users

1. Mac users need to use the PC version of Brio via MIT's Citrix server (Citrix is a PC emulator that allows people to use PC versions of enterprise applications that do not have native OS X versions on their Mac OS X machines: Brio is one of these applications. Instructions for installing and using Citrix are on the warehouse web page)
2. Follow the instructions from the following link:

### Windows Users

1. Open MIT's software page - <http://mit.edu/software/win.html>
2. BrioQuery requires the installation of Oracle 9 Client and the 9i client requires that you first uninstall earlier versions (which can be reinstalled later if need for other reasons)
3. Download the following files from the software page: Oracle Uninstaller, Oracle 9i Client Core, TNS Names Updater. In order:
4. Install Oracle Uninstaller
5. Install Oracle 9i Client Core
6. Install the TNS Names Updater.
7. Install BrioQuery 6.6.4.44
8. Set your Data Warehouse password if you have not already done so.
9. After the installation of BrioQuery, the reports can be downloaded from the Data Warehouse. The training reports are still in draft form and should go into production in the next couple of weeks.

11. Scroll down to the EHS Training reports and select "Pc6"
12. Run the reports from the icon on your desktop
