Guidelines:

- Submit papers to harvardmitgrad@gmail.com by February 6th, 2022. Papers should be no more than 4000 words, with abstracts of no more than 250 words, and must be suitable for a 40-45 minute presentation. Please include 2-5 keywords for your topic. All submissions must be in PDF or Word formats. Papers should be prepared for blind review, with file name: HM2022_*Title*.
- Submit a separate cover letter in PDF or Word format with the following details: name, paper title, institutional affiliation, and contact information.
- Authors must be current graduate students in philosophy. Co-authored papers are permitted if all authors are current graduate students.
- Successful applicants will be notified by March 1st, 2022.
