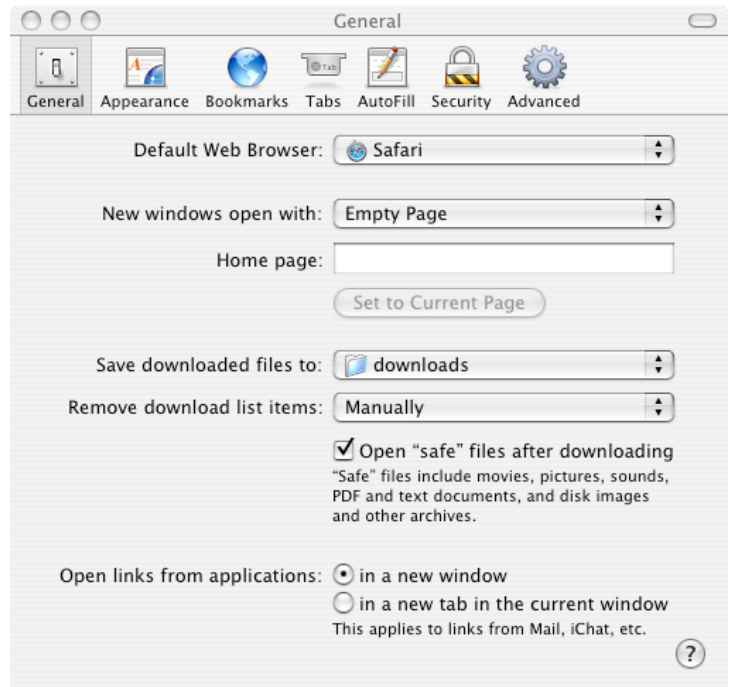


Downloading from archive.org

To download quickly from archive.org, you'll need to change your Safari browser preferences. If you are using another browser, you should still change the download preferences for that browser too.

- 1) Go to the Safari menu and choose "Preferences..."
- 2) In the General tab of the Preferences window, click on the "Save downloaded files to:" pop-up menu and choose "Other..."
- 3) Select your firewire drive from the left-hand column and then click the new folder button. Name the folder "downloads" and then click the "Select" button.
- 4) Close the Preferences window.



- 5) Go to archive.org

Once you have found a movie that you would like to download.

- 6) Right-click the MPEG2 file found in the Download column on the left-hand side of the browser window. Choose "Download Linked File," from the contextual menu.

When the file has finished downloading, use MPEG Streamclip to convert the file for use in Final Cut Pro. See separate directions for using MPEG Streamclip.
