

Using MPEG Streamclip to convert archive.org mpeg files to FCP-ready quicktime files

Streamclip is a demuxing and transcoding software. You can use it to alter the mpeg-2 files from the archive.org website for use in Final Cut Pro with no rendering.

- 1) Open the application "MPEG Streamclip" - found in the /Applications/VIDEO directory.
- 2) Drag your file from the Finder into the MPEG Streamclip window - the area with the blue dots.
- 3) From the MPEG Streamclip "File" menu, choose "Export to Quicktime..."
- 4) In the Movie Exporter window, change the following settings:
 - a) Compression: pop-up menu to "Apple DV/DVCPRO - NTSC"
 - b) Quality: slider to 100%.
 - c) Sound: Uncompressed, Stereo, 48kHz
 - d) Check the "Deinterlace Video" box.
- 5) Click the "Make Movie" button.
- 6) Once the .mov file is finished, drag it into the FCP Browser window
