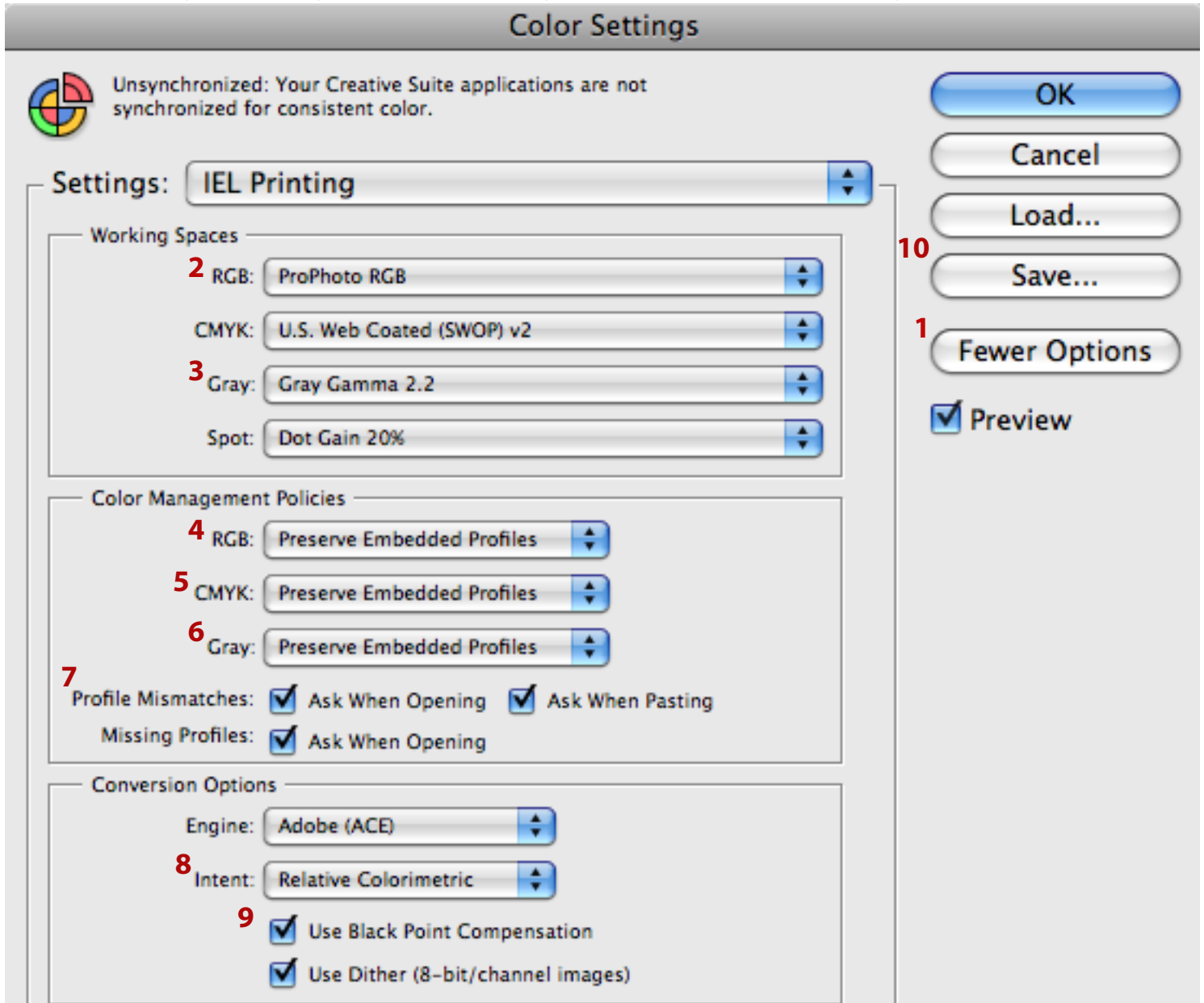


Photoshop • Color Settings

ADJUSTING THE COLOR SETTINGS

- 1) Access the Photoshop Color Settings window by going to the Edit menu --> Color Settings...
- 2) Change the settings in the "Color Settings" window to match the following screen shot:



In the righthand column, (1) Click the More Options button.

In the Working Spaces section, (2) change RGB: to ProPhoto RGB, (3) change Gray: to Gray Gamma 2.2.

In the Color Management section, (4, 5, 6) Change RGB;,CMYK;, and Gray: to Preserve Embedded Profiles.

(7) Check the boxes for Profile Mismatches and Missing Profiles.

In the Conversion Options section, (8) Change Intent to Relative Colorimetric. (9) Check the Use Black Point Compensation box.

(10) Click the "Save..." button.

3) In the Save Dialogue window, name your color settings file "IEL Printing". Save file into the directory: MacData-->Library-->Application Support-->Adobe-->Color-->Settings.

4) In the comments window, write "RGB Inkjet Photo Printing in the IEL" and click the OK button.

5) Back in the Color Settings window, click the OK button.
